 - Reading assessments were discussed (use of Heggerty, Fundations & Acadians)
 - Also quick discussion of Orton-Gillingham and Speyer as supplementary assessments
 - Discussion of Math and updates on District 3 decisions regarding the future math curriculum. Impressions were:
 - Illustrative Maths have engagement
